I, L.A. Macumber of the said County and State being sworn depose and say that I was well acquainted with Alex. Johnson who is named as grantee in a deed conveying to him the West half of the South East Quarter of Section 33, of Township 75 North, Range 28 West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, which deed is recorded in Deed Record 2 at page 606 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa, and I know that he is the same identical person as the Alexander Johnson who with his wife conveyed the same land to John A. Macumber which deed is recorded in deed record 2 at page 400 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa. That said Johnson is my cousin and I was well acquainted with him.

That the John A. Macumber who is named as Grantee in a deed for said real estate recorded in Deed Record 2 at page 400 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa is the same identical person as the J.A. Macumber who is named as grantor in a deed for said real estate to Henry Macumber which deed is recorded in deed record 7 at page 454 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa. That the said John A. Macumber was my father and I of course am well acquainted with these facts.

That I was well acquainted with Margaret Macumber who was at one time the wife of Henry Macumber and she is the same identical person who is named in this chain of title as Maggie E. Macumber, her true name was Margaret E. Macumber. And she was sometimes called Maggie Macumber. And that wherever the name of Margaret Macumber or Maggie Macumber appears in this chain of title it refers to the same identical person.
