Rnge 27 Madison County Iowa, and know that she is the same and identical person whose name appears as Mary Hughes in the list of heirs in the estate of John Montgomery.

I also know that John Faurote to whom Mary A. Montgomery signed a quit claim deed Sept 1st, 1887 conveying the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16 Twp 76 N. Rnge 27 is the same identical person whose name appears as John A. Faurote in a Warranty Deed to the same property to Josiah E. Missildine dated June 1st 1880.
