Cracraft who conveyed by Warranty Deed the South east quarter of North east quarter of Section 16 Twp 76 N. Range 27 to Josiah E. Missildine on Sept 23rd 1873 and know she was the same identical person whose name appears as Rebeca Ann Cracraft in deed to the above described property from Thomas Garlinger and wife Rachel dated Nov 14th 1863 and recorded in the records of Madison County Iowa.

That I was well and personally acquainted with Josiah E. Missildine, mentioned as grantee in a deed from John A. Faurote and wife Olevia to the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16 Twp 76 N Range 27 dated June 1st 1880 and recorded in the records of Madison County Iowa, and with Josiah E. Missildine and Joseph E. Missildine mentioned as grantee in a deed from Rebecca A. Cracraft to the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16 Twp 76 N. Range 27 dated June 1st 1880 and with J. E. Missildine who died on the 3rd day of Sept 1885 and whose estate was probated in the District Court of Iowa in and for Madison County as Probate #573 and that they are one and the same person.
