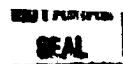

State of Iowa Madison County, SS. I, J.E. Hamilton, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath depose and say that I am the person named in a deed from Benjamin N. Campbell and wife, to J.V. McClure, dated June 25, 1913, conveying N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 14-76-27 said deed being recorded in Deed Record 54, at page 173, of the deed records of Madison County, Iowa, that the recital in said deed, that the same is made subject to an encumbrance of \$600.00 in my favor, was an error, that I never at any time held or owned any mortgage or other encumbrance on the land above described, and the recital excepting the mortgage of \$600.00 in said deed, in truth and in fact referred to a balance of \$600.00 due on a certain mortgage of \$1700 given by Oscar N. Norris and wife, to William F. Gentry, and which balance of said mortgage was at the time of the execution of said deed, owned and held by the First National Bank of Winterset, Iowa, of which corporation, I am and was at that time, Vice President, and as such officer conducted the negotiations whereby said bank became the owner thereof, that I have no interest in making this affidavit except to establish the facts herein stated.
