I, J.E.Tidrick, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say:—That I am now, and for more than ten years last past have been a practicing attorney at law in Winterset, Iowa, that in 1911, 1912 and up to June 1st, 1913, I was in the employ of Jno. A & W.T. Guher in their law office in Winterset, Iowa, that during such time and acting in the capacity of clerk in said office I had full charge of the settling of the estate of William Fleming who died seized of the West Half of Sec. 11-77-29 and of the partition action of Edward A.
