I, Wm Brinson being first duly sworn on oath do depose and say: That I came to Madison County, Iowa, in the year of 1849: That I was well and personally acquainted with Levi Smith who once owned the North West Quarter (1/4) of the South West Quarter (1/4) of section Thirty-six (36) in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M., Iowa, and who sold said above described real estate by warranty deed on September, 28, 1853, to John A. Pitzer, which deed was recorded in Deed Record "A" on page 212 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa, on January, 9, 1854: that I was also well and personally acquainted with Margaret A. Cochran who married said Levi Smith, and that said Margaret A. Cochran-Smith died on or about April, 3, 1857: that the said Levi Smith herein referred to died on or about December, 19, 1894.
