I, T.C.Gilpin, being first duly sworn, on oath depose and say that I am a practicing attorney, that I have resided in Winterset, Madison County, Iowa, continuously since the year 1865 and was engaged in the active practice of the law in said city from 1865 to about the year 1904, that I was personally and well acquainted with Milton C.Munger and Nelson M.Munger, Brothers who are named as grantees in a certain deed from Luther R.Boxley and wife, dated Jan.30,1856, conveying the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 2 and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 1-75-27, recorded in Deed Record "D", at page 359 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa, and know of my own personal knowledge that the Nelson M.Munger named as grantee therein and the N.W.Munger named as grantor in a certain deed dated Jan.12,1857, conveying SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec.2-75-27, recorded in Deed Record "F", at page 300 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, are one and the same identical person and the recording of his name as Nelson M.Munger in the deed first herein described was an error of the Recorder or of the person drawing the said deed.

I further depose and say that I was the attorney for plaintiff Loring McMillen in Action No.4003, Equity, in which the petition was filed Jan.24,1857 to foreclose a certain mortgage executed by Joseph M.Crow and wife to Justus B.Johnson and know of my own personal knowledge that the said Loring McMillen plaintiff in said action was the same

and identical person as the L. McMillen named as assignee in assignment of the said mortgage made by Geo W. Meade executor of J. B. Johnson; deceased, dated June 22, 1885, and was the same identical person as the Loreing McMillen named as grantor in a warranty deed to Norman H. Becker, dated July 22, 1889, and recorded in Book 28, at page 8, of the deed records of Madison County, Iowa, conveying SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 2-75-27.

That I have no interest in making this affidavit, except to establish the facts herein stated, all of which is made from personal knowledge.
