Shaw, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well acquainted with Samuel Krell, who at one time owned the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 26, and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 27, Township 75 North, Range 29 West of the 5th P.M., and with the members of his family, that the said Samuel Krell died intestate in Warren County, Iowa, about April, 1902, leaving surviving him his widow, Barbara Krell, and as his heirs at law, his children, S.A.
