I, Sarah E. Cunningham, of said county and state, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath depose and say that I am a daughter of John E. Harrison, who died seized of the NE 1/4 21-75-29, that my brother George W. Harrison and my sister Mary Alice Harrison both died intestate, unmarried and without issue in the Spring of 1880, that they died from diphtheria and within two weeks of each other, both being sick at the same time and both dying at the home of my parents in Madison County, Iowa.
