McClelland to whom the United States Government Patented the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 3-75-27,
and know that he was the same and identical person as the Benjamin McClellan
who, together with his wife, conveyed said land to Henry Cox by deed dated September 1st
1854 and recorded in Deed Record 2, page 237.

I further depose and say that the James Hamner who, together with his wife, conveyed
said real estate to Thomas Neely by deed dated January 2nd 1865 and recorded in
Record "D" page 422 was the same and identical person as the James Hamner who ob-
tained title to said land by deed from Henry Cox and wife, dated February 4th 1856
and recorded in Record "D", page 305, his correct name being James Hamner, and he being
the father of this affiant.
