State of Iowa Mahaska County, SS. I, W. H. Keating, of said County and State, on oath say that I, on or about May 13th, 1910, wrote the last will and testament of James Loughridge, of said County and State which last will and testament was admitted to probate by the District Court of said County, on or about October 10th, A. D. 1910.

That I remember writing the seventh paragraph of said will by which certain provision is made for the "Foreign Mission Society of the United Presbyterian Church of America"; that I wrote said provision, at the request of said James Loughridge to make provision for the interest of the Foreign Missions of the United Presbyterian Church of North America; that at that time I did not know the correct Corporate name of the Board or Society of the United Presbyterian Church in this Country having charge or control of its Foreign Mission interests, and such correct Corporate name was not at the time given me, and as I remember the correct corporate name was not known to said James Loughridge or to any one else present at the time, and the name "Foreign Mission Society of the United Presbyterian Church of America" was inserted in the will as being as nearly like the correct corporate name as we at the time knew or could ascertain. That I have since learned that the correct corporate name of the only Society or

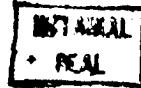
Board having any thing to do with the interests of the Foreign Missions of the said United Presbyterian Church is "Board of Foreign Missions of the United Presbyterian Church of North America", and that I now know that such Corporate name should have been used instead of the name that was used, and that the beneficiary intended in the seventh paragraph of said will is in fact the Board of Foreign Missions of the United Presbyterian Church of North America.
