State of New York Fulton County SS. I, Eugene D. Heacock, on oath say that I am the son and only heir at law of Jane A. Heacock who died intestate in said County on or about the 12th day of August, A.D. 1898; that I was administrator of the estate of Jane A. Heacock, and that said estate has long since been fully settled, and all debts paid.

That I remember of Jane A. Heacock having a mortgage executed by J.G. Seward and wife Sadie E. Seward, dated in or about June 18, 1895, securing the payment of two hundred (200) dollars, and covering the north west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the south east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section twenty two (22) in township seventy four (74) north, of range twenty seven (27), west of the 5th P.M., Iowa, which appeared of record in mortgage record thirty (30) of Madison County, Iowa, at page 388 thereof; that the indebtedness secured by said mortgage has been fully paid; that on April 1st, 1899, I sent to have placed of record in Madison County, Iowa, a release of said mortgage, executed by my self as administrator of the estate of Jane A. Heacock, together with a certificate of my authority to execute such release as administrator of her estate; that I am now advised that such release is not of record; that I have now been discharged as administrator of said estate, but for the purpose of releasing said mortgage, I now, as the heir at law of said Jane A. Heacock, and the person who would be entitled to said mortgage if the same were not satisfied, do hereby release, cancel, and discharge said mortgage of record, for the reason that the same was long since fully paid and satisfied.
