State of Iowa Madison County, ss. I, A.B.Moorman, of said County and State being first
duly sworn do upon my oath depose and say:-

That my wife is a daughter of A.G.Martin and Elizabeth Martin. That the said A.G. Martin died testate during the winter of 1867 and 1868: That at the time of the death of the said A.G.Martin, he was the owner of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section Thirty-four (34) in Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.M., and part of said land was afterwards owned by Eliza Clevonger. That the said A.G.Martin left surviving him Elizabeth Martin, his widow, and that the said Elizabeth Martin was sick at the time of the death of the said A.G.Martin, and that she never recovered. That she died intestate during the year 1868 at the home of this affiant in Madison County, Iowa. That after the death of the said Elizabeth Martin, the devisee, W.R.Martin claimed to be the owner of the real estate bequeathed to him by the said A.G.Martin and that no one, ^{or more} of the other heirs at law of A.G.Martin or Elizabeth Martin ever claimed any interest in or to the property bequeathed to W.R.Martin by the said A.G.Martin, deceased, but at all times treated it as his absolute property.
