Hoover, of said State and County, being first duly sworn, do upon my oath, depose and say:- That I was personally and well acquainted with Warren Allcock named as grantee in a deed from myself and wife, Sarah J. Hoover, dated April 20th, 1906, conveying S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 20-75-26, recorded in Deed Record 47 at Page 592 of the records of Madison County, Iowa and know that he was the same identical person as the W.C. Allcock who executed a deed for the same land to me dated March 19th, 1909 and recorded in Deed Record 49 at page 285 of said records; I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Norvell S. Allcock named as grantee in a certain deed from Edward M. Greenway, Jr. dated September 1st, 1854, conveying the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 19-75-26 and recorded in Deed Record "A" at Page 626 of the records of Madison County, Iowa and know of my own knowledge that he was the same and identical person as the N.S. Allcock named as grantor in a deed to The Heirs of William Eldridge, dated September 12th, 1892, conveying the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 19-75-26 and recorded in Deed Record 37 at Page 415 of said Madison County, Iowa records and know that on said date, to-wit:- September 12th, 1892 the said Norvell S. Allcock or N.S. Allcock (being one and the same person) was a married man. That I have no interest to serve in making this affidavit except to establish the facts herein set forth. Further deponent sayeth not.
