

State of Iowa, Madison County, ss. I, A.M. Benge, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say:- That I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, continuously since the year 1855; that I was personally and well acquainted with A.J. Adkinson, named as grantor in a certain deed from Josephine Bartlett and husband, dated May 23rd, 1872, recorded in Deed Record 6 at Page 530, conveying Lots 5 and 6 in Block 7 in Loughridge & Cassidy's Addition to Winterset, Iowa and know of my own personal knowledge that he was the same and identical person as the A.J. Adkinson, named as grantor in a certain deed conveying the same real estate to William W. Bartlett and Elam H. Stafford, dated October 29th, 1872 and recorded in Deed Record 7 at Page 110; both references to deed records herein being to the deed records in the office of the County Recorder of Madison County, Iowa. That said A.J. Adkinson or A.J. Adkinson (being one and the same person) was my father-in-law and I have personal knowledge of the facts stated herein. That I have no interest in making this affidavit except to establish the facts herein stated. Further deponent sayeth not.
