The township trustees of Jackson Twp met and located a tile ditch commencing about forty (40) rds west of the Southeast corner of the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec twenty Twp 76 R 29 and running thence in a northeasterly direction to a point about 2 rds north of south east corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec 20 and shall empty into an open ditch.

And also located a ditch commencing about 30 rds west of the SE corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 20 to run in a northwesterly direction and strike the first proposed ditch as above stated about ten (10) rds north of the south end thereof.

The proposed ditches to be constructed of six inch field tile to be placed three (3) feet in the ground and that said ditch be an independent ditch.

That the owner of said land shall not have the right to connect with said ditch.

That said ditch shall be constructed by A.H. Nelson who shall have the right to enter upon said land and repair said ditch.
