

State of Iowa, Madison County, ss. I, E.B. Hiatt, being first duly sworn do upon my oath depose and say that I am now County Engineer of Madison County Iowa and have been for quite a while and that I personally know from actual surveys that I made while I was City Engineer of the City of Winterset Iowa the following statements to be true and correct:

1st. That the west side of Front Street in the plat of the Original Town Of Winterset Iowa is the section line on the West side of West Half of the South-west Quarter of Section 31 Township 76 North, Range 27 West of the 5th P.M.

2nd.- That Court Avenue runs due East from the said Front Street and the center of Court Avenue is 1539.67 Feet North of the South-west Corner of said Section 31, Township 76 North Range 27 West of the 5th P.M.

3rd.- That the North-west corner of Block Two (2) of Gaff & Bevington's Addition to the Town of Winterset Iowa is 1056 feet east of the west side of said Front Street in the said Original Town of Winterset Iowa.

4th.- That the said Block Two (2) of the said Gaff & Bevington Addition is located on Out Lot Four (4) instead of Out Lot Five (5) of the East Out Lot Addition.
