State of Iowa Madison County, ss; I, W.W. McKnight, being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I am a resident of Madison County, Iowa; that I was well and personally acquainted with William Loughridge during his life time; that the William Loughridge grantee in a deed recorded in Deed Record "E" page 373, dated April 11th, 1857 conveying Block 13 of Loughridge & Cassiday's Addition to Winterset, Iowa, and other property, and the Wm. Loughridge grantor in a deed recorded in Deed Record 2 page 555, dated November 21st, 1870 conveying the same property, are one and the same identical person, his correct name being William Loughridge; that he was a single and unmarried man at the time he executed the deed recorded in deed Record 2 page 555 on the 21st. day of November 1870.

That I was well and personally acquainted with Alexander M. Cassiday during his life time, and of my own personal knowledge know that he was a single and unmarried man on the 15th day of September 1855 at which time he executed a Mortgage to A.T. Marshall recorded in Record "B" page 203, also that he was a single and unmarried man on the 17th day Of March 1858 at which time he was defendant in the proceedings to foreclose the above mortgage, that the Alexander M. Cassiday, grantor in, and the A.M. Cassiday, defendant in said action were one and the same identical person.

That I have no interest in the making of this affidavit except to establish of record the facts as herein set forth.
