State of Iowa, Madison County, ss I, T. E. Smith, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say:— That I was a son of O. H. Smith, who died intestate in Madison County, Iowa on or about May 18th 1910, seized in fee of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 23 and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 26 and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 27 all in Twp 75 North, Range 29 West of 5th P.M., and am the same person who was appointed administrator of his estate by the Clerk of the District Court of said County on June 11th, 1910; That I know of my own personal knowledge that my said father O. H. Smith, resided in Webster Township, Madison County, Iowa continuously from about 1868 until his death in 1910 and never resided in or had any personal property subject to taxation in any other Township in said County; that any personal taxes assessed or levied against O. H. Smith in either Monroe Township or Grand River Township, in said County, for the years 1899, 1900, 1901, 1903, 1904, 1905, 1906, 1907 or 1898 were levied and assessed against another person than my father, O. H. Smith, and the same are not and never have been a lien or charge against any of the real estate owned by my father during his lifetime. That I have no interest in making this affidavit except to establish the facts herein stated.
