McCleary named as one of the grantees in the Quit Claim Deed executed by Primrose Walker, dated December 13th, 1913, conveying Lot Seven (7), Block Eleven (11) of Pitzer & Knight's Addition, and recorded in Town Lot Deed Record 13 at page 249 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa; that the personal taxes levied against C.A.
