I, Clarence Macumber, being first duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I am a grandson of John Macumber to whom Jacob Casteel and wife conveyed the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 15-75-28 by deed dated October 13th 1858 and recorded in Record "H", page 530; but that by mistake or error the name of the said John Macumber appears in the record of said deed as John McCumber.

I further depose and say that the said John Macumber was the same and identical person as the John A. Macumber who, together with his wife, conveyed the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec 15-75-28 to Alexander Macumber by deed dated February 24th 1866 and recorded in Record "Q", page 443; and as the John A. Macumber to whom the said Alexander Macumber and wife conveyed said last described land by deed dated June 29th 1872 and recorded in Deed Record 6, page 566; and as the J. A. Macumber who conveyed said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 15-75-28 to W. W. Greer by deed dated December 8th 1888 and recorded in Deed Record 27, page 164.

I further depose and say that the Alexander Macumber named as grantee in above named deed recorded in Record "Q", page 443 was the same and identical person as the Alexander Macumber or A. L. Macumber who joined in executing the above mentioned conveyance recorded in Deed Record 6, page 565. All of the above records being of Madison County, Iowa.
