That the said Sarah Lewis or Sarah Lake was the same person as the Sarah Lake who together with her hisband executed a Quit Claim Deed for above described land to John A.Rogers on February 27° 1874, said deed being recorded in Deed Record 10, page 636, and that the above named William Lewis and Eva A.Lewis executed a Quit Claim Deed for said land to John A.Rogers on January 27° 1883, said deed being recorded in Deed Record 14, page 380, and that on the date of said last mentioned deed the said William Lewis and the said Eva A.Lewis had each attained majority, were each married and were competent to convey.

I further depose and say that the Joseph J. Hutchings who was one of the grantees

in above mentioned deed dated November 27" 1863, and recorded in Record " K", page 434 conveying the SEL NEL Sec 16-75-27, and other land, was the same identical person as the J.J. Hutchings who together with his wife conveyed the undivided 1 of raid lant described land to W.W. McKnight by deed dated August 31" 1864 and recorded in Record "K", page 567.
