Cooper was Fichmond D. Cooper; that he was the same and identical man as the Richard Cooper or Richmond Cooper named as grantee in a conveyance from Hampton Jones and wife dated on or about November 22nd, 1851, conveying to him the east half (1) of the north west quarter (+) of said section eighteen (18) in the fownship and range aforesaid; that If the name of said grantee appears in the record as Richard Cooper it is only by reas on of clerical error and mistake, as his correct name was Richmond Cooper or Richmond D. Cooper, and that he was the same man as the grantee in a conveyance from Silas Barnes and wife of the south half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the south east quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of the south west quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of said section seven (7) in the township and range aforesaid; that in the chain of title to the last described tract the names Silas Barnes and Silas Barns refer to one and the same man, the variation in spelling being due only to carelessness or mistake in drawing the conveyances.
