Dorrell, of said County and State, on oath say that I have lived in Madison County, Iowa, continuously for more than sixty years last past; that I have been acquainted with the possession and occupancy of lots seven (7) and eight (8) in block seven (7) in Laughridge & Cassidy's Addition to Winterset, Iowa, for more than fifty years last past; that O.H. Harland, to whom A. Pattison and wife on or about June 16th, 1862, conveyed lot eight (8) in said Block seven (7) in Laughridge & Cassidy's Addition to Winterset, Iowa, was the same and identical person as the Oliver H. Harlan who on or about October 21st 1862, conveyed the same property to Christian Mosler; that at that time there were several families in Winterset, Iowa, of the same name, and that they were called indiscriminately Harland and Harlan; that I was also acquainted with W.W. Bartlett who acquired title to both of said lots seven (7) and eight (8) in Block seven (7) in said Laughridge & Cassidy's Addition to Winterset, Iowa, and that the name of the wife of said W.W. Bartlett was Rebecca; that I am unable to remember the middle initial of her name, but that the Rebecca Bartlett who joined with W.W. Bartlett in a conveyance of said property to M. Polk on or about October 9th, 1874, was the then wife of said W.W. Bartlett.
