State of Iowa, Madison County. ss. I, W.W. McKnight a resident of the State and County aforesaid being first duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with the persons whose names are below mentioned and of my personal knowledge know the facts as herein set forth.

That Stephen B. Clark who entered and to whom patent was issued for the whole of Section No. 15, Township 76 North, Range 29 West 5th P.M. of Iowa, was the same and identical person as the S.B. Clark who together with his wife Jane Clark on January 30th 1871, conveyed the West Half of said section to Samuel Ralston, Robert Ralston and James B. Ralston as shown by Deed Record 5 page 33 of the records of Madison County, Iowa.

That P.B. Sprague and N.S. Sprague were husband and wife, and Edward Brown and Sarah J. Brown were husband and wife, on April 26th 1875 at which time they conveyed to Emil Allgeyer the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of 15-76-29, as shown by Deed Record 11 page 141 of said records, and that said Edward Brown is the same and identical person as the Ed Brown who acquired title to said land by Sheriff's Deed recorded in Deed Record "A" page 47 of said records.

That Emil Allgeyer was a single and unmarried man on September 9th 1875, at which time he conveyed the last above described land to Moses Norman, as shown by Deed Record 12 page 115 of said records.

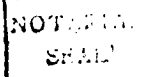
That James Aitchison to whom C.P. Cline on March 13th 1889 conveyed the last above described land as shown by Deed Record 27 page 269 of said records, is the same and identical

person as the James F. Aitchison who conveyed said land to John F. Aitchison as shown by Deed Record 43 page 380 of said records.
