Hamner, being first duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I was acquainted with Samuel Fleener, Jr., who entered the  $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 2-75-27, and to whom said land was patented by the United States <sup>Government</sup> on June 10<sup>th</sup> 1851, and know that he was the same and identical person as the Samuel Fleener, who, together with his wife, subsequently conveyed said land to John A. Rogers, by deed dated March 23<sup>rd</sup> 1852 and recorded in Deed Record 23 page, 349.

I further depose and say that the E. Peak named as one of the grantees in a certain deed executed by F. D. Campbell and wife, dated February 22<sup>nd</sup> 1890 and recorded in Deed Record 27, page 587, conveying the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 2-75-27, was the same and identical person as the Elza Peak, who subsequently conveyed the undivided half of said land to G. H. Linnaird, by deed dated March 2<sup>nd</sup> 1899 and recorded in Deed Record 38, page 535, and that in said <sup>last</sup> mentioned deed, the name of grantee, through error, was spelled "Kinriard" his correct name being G. H. Kinnaird, and that said G. H. Kinnaird was the same and identical person as the G. H. Kinriard named as one of the grantees in above mentioned deed recorded in Deed Record 27, page 587. All of the above named records being of Madison County, Iowa.
