

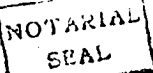

I, C.S.Crawford, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I am a son of Oliver Crawford, who died in Madison County, Iowa, about June 11th 1869, and the Probate Proceedings in whose estate are shown in Probate Docket "B" page 81; and of Lucinda Crawford, who died in Madison County, Iowa, about ----- 1878, and the Probate Proceedings in whose estate are shown in Probate Docket "B", page 86, and know that in the Probate Proceedings of each of said estate and the various actions at law, relating to the land belonging to said estate, M.J.Crawford, M.J.Stiles or Mary E Stiles refer to one and the same person: that R.J.Crawford is the same and identical person as Robert J. Crawford; that E.E.Crawford is the same and identical person as E.E.Gordon, Elizabeth Gordon or Elizabeth E.Wright, and also as the Elizabeth E.Wright named as grantor in deed recorded in Deed Record 23, page 441; That M.T.Crawford is the same and identical person as M.T. Stiles, Maria Stiles or Maria T. Stiles; that W.W.Crawford is the same and identical person as Wm. W.Crawford or William W. Crawford; that C.S.Crawford, this affiant, is the same and identical person as Charley S.crawford, Charles S.crawford, or Chas S.Crawford; and that the name Crawford was erroneously spelled "Crofford" in the return of service of the Original Notice in the Partition Proceedings wherein Lucinda Crawford was plaintiff and the heirs at law of Oliver Crawford were defendants. All of the above named records being of Madison County, Iowa.
