I, Harry W. Hill, being first duly affirmed, depose and say I have been a continuous resident of Earlham, Madison County, Iowa, for over thirty years just passed and that during this time I have been personally acquainted with one Phillip Peter Schlarb plaintiff in a petition of equity of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34 and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the South thirty-seven (37) acres of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27- all in Township Seventy-seven (77) North, Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa; and that the said Phillip Peter Schlarb is one and the same party as P.P. Schlarb grantee in a certain Referee's deed dated December 8, 1910, recorded in Madison County records and approved by Court December 12, 1910, and P.P. Schlarb grantor in a certain ^{warranty} deed dated Dec 10, 1911, said deed filed for record in Madison County record book 50, page 119; and that wherever in the chain of title to the above described real estate the name of Phillip Peter Schlarb and P.P. Schlarb appears it refers to one and the same person. I give this from my personal knowledge of the party and also personal knowledge of his interest in the title to the above described real estate.

I further state I am personally and well acquainted with Charles L. Curell and Walter P. Curell, grantees in a certain warranty deed dated March 10, 1911, recorded in Madison

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record book 50, page 119, and that Charles L. Curell and Walter P. Curell are the same parties as C. L. Curell and W. P. Curell, grantors in a certain mortgage dated March 28, 1912 filed in Madison County record book 53, page 539, and that wherever in the chain of title to the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Thirty-four (34) and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the south thirty seven (37) acres of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Twenty-seven (27) all in Township Seventy-seven (77) North, Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. the name of Charles L. Curell and Walter P. Curell or C. L. Curell ^{and W. P. Curell} is mentioned it refers to one and the same party.
