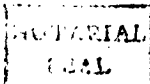

Hamilton, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than 40 years, last past, except a period of one year when I resided in Colorado; That I resided in Walnut Township (Being Township Seventy-four (74) North of Range Twenty-Seven (27) West of the 5th P. M.) in said County until the year 1900; That during the summer and fall of the year 1880 I worked for one J. E. White and have a personal knowledge of the said J. E. White being nominated and elected as Justice of the Peace in the fall of 1880 and of his qualification as such in January 1881, and I well and personally know that the said J. E. White acted as such Justice of the Peace continually from the time of his qualification as such in January 1881 until I moved from said Township in the year 1900.
