That prior to the platting of Pitzer & Knight's Addition, the North end of Polk Street referred to in a certain deed executed by John A. Pitzer and wife to Charles Crane and recorded in Record "A", page 200, was at the South line of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 36-76-28.
