State of Iowa, Madison County, ss. I, W.G. Derrell, being first duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, since 1846 and have been in and around Winterset since 1860; that I was acquainted with Isaac Stouder who acquired title to Lots 5 and 6 in Block 3 of West Addition to Winterset, Iowa, on September 23rd 1864, by deed recorded in Record "O", page 158, and that the spelling of his name as Isaac Stouder as the same appears of record in Record "O", page 158 must have been a mistake, either of the scrivener in drawing the deed or of the Recorder in recording the same, as I never knew of anyone by the name of Isaac Strouder owning said lots or claiming title to the same.

I further depose and say that said Isaac Stouder was the same and identical person as the Isaac Stouder who subsequently conveyed above described lots to W.C. Newlon on December 7th 1867, by deed recorded in Record "V", page 338; All of the above named records being of Madison County, Iowa.
