That I was personally acquainted with Benj. Hircocck who with his wife conveyed to Ira C. Walker, all that part of the West Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Five (5) in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.M. lying South of North River, by warranty deed dated July 12th, 1872, and recorded in Deed Record 7 page 205 of Madison County, Iowa, and knew that he is the same person as the Benjamin Hircocck to whom the same real estate was conveyed by John Clear and wife on March 31st 1871, as is shown by Deed Record 6 page 74 of said county and state.

That the Ira C. Walker who was named as grantee in the said deed first above named

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described herein and recorded in Deed Record 7 page 205 of said county and state, was my husband, and the same person as the I.C. Walker who joined with me in a deed of conveyance of the same land to Thomas Dee, said deed being dated December 27th, 1875, and being recorded in Deed Record 11 page 586 of said county and state.
