Bray and wife conveyed the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 20-74-29 by deed dated November 14th 1867 and recorded in Deed Record "V" page 168, and that the said John H. Marley was the same person as the J. H. Marley who afterward with his wife conveyed said land to Andrew J. Cecil by deed dated May 5th 1868 and recorded in Record "V" page 446, and also that the said Andrew J. Cecil was the same person as the A. J. Cecil who with his wife convey said land to L. N. Conway by deed dated April 6th 1876 and recorded in Deed Record 13, page 74; and also that the said L. N. Conway was the same person as the Loid N. Conway to whom Hale C. Conway and wife conveyed the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 20-74-29 by deed dated February 7th 1875 and recorded in Deed Record 11, page 220, and also as the L. N. Conway who with his wife conveyed the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 20-74-29 to L. A. Conway by deed dated October 1st 1889 and recorded in Deed Record 30, page 90, and as the L. N. Conway to whom the said L. A. Conway re-conveyed said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 20-74-29 by deed dated January 2nd 1892 and recorded in Deed Record 32, page 245, and as the Lloyd N. Conway who with his wife conveyed said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 20-74-29 to James L. Bertholf by deed dated February 1st 1904 and recorded in Deed Record 43, page 570.

I further depose and say that the Jacob Marly to whom Beeson Barker and wife conveyed the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 20-74-29 by deed dated April 20th 1860 and recorded in Deed Record "P", page 250 was the same person as the Jacob Marley who with his wife afterward conveyed said land to Luther Cranmer by deed dated August 21st 1867 and recorded in Record "W" page 331, and that the said Luther Cranmer was the same person as the L. Cranmer who with his wife conveyed said land to David R. Clark by deed dated September 11th 1875 and recorded in Deed Record 11, page 419.

I further depose and say that Amasa M. Brown to whom William Groesback conveyed the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 20-74-29 by deed dated August 26th 1871 and recorded in Deed Record 11, page 338 was the same person as the A. M. Brown who with his wife afterward conveyed the undivided $\frac{1}{2}$ of said land to Jasper N. and John Maze by deed dated October 25th 1877 and recorded in Deed Record 19, page 463, and as the A. M. Brown who afterward conveyed the other undivided $\frac{1}{2}$ of said land to L. N. Conway by deed dated May 3rd 1881 and recorded in Deed Record 19, page 483; and that the Jasper N. and John Maze mentioned above were the same persons as the J. N. Maze and J. L. Maze who conveyed the undivided $\frac{1}{2}$ of above described land L. N.

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Conway by deed dated December 31st 1883 and recorded in Deed Record 23, page 314,
