Goodie on Aug 21st 1890 executed a warranty deed, recorded in Madison County, Records, Town Lot Deed Record 7 page 204 and the Chas D. Marshall mentioned as grantor in a deed executed April 14, 1893 to H.R. Proudfoot recorded in Madison County Records, Town Lot deed Records 8 page 143 were one and the same identical person.

I further state that I know the said Chas. D. Marshall on April 14, 1893 a was a single person. I further state that I have been acquainted with one Geo. H. Cheek for the past 25 years and know that the George H. Cheek to whom Chas Marshall executed a mortgage for \$100.00 recorded in Mortgage Record 16 page 99 of Madison County Records and the G.H. Cheek who executed a Release of Mortgage to Chas Marshall recorded in Miscellaneous Record 10 page 501 of Madison County Records are one and the same identical person. Referring to the marginal release of mortgage in Town Lot Mortgage Record 5 page 476, I further state that the J.N. Smith who signed the marginal release, April 15th 1902 was at that time a member of the firm of Killam & Smith.

I further state that I have been acquainted for many years with J.M. Bell one of the grantors in Quit Claim deed recorded April 8th 1907 in Town Lot Record 7 page 560 of Madison County Records who signed his name in that deed as John M. Bell and say that J.M. Bell and John M. Bell are one and the same identical person.
