Yocum at the time of his decease, with full power and authority, to secure and collect the said property and debts wheresoever the same may be found in this State, and in general, to do and perform all other acts which now are or hereafter may be required of him by law.

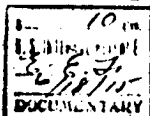
