Wauchope who heretofore owned the lot numbered eight in block number thirteen (13) of Loughridge and Cassidays's in addition to the town of Winterset, Iowa, and that the Olive A. Wauchope upon her decease left no husband surviving.

I also depose and say that the Jay Maxwell Wauchope named as one of the devisees in the will of the said Olive A. Wauchope was my brother and that he was one and the same identical person as the J. Max Wauchope named in the registry of heirs filed April 25th, 1912, in the estate of said Olive A. Wauchope, deceased, and the J. Max Wauchope who, together with his wife, Pearl, conveyed above described property to me by quit claim deed bearing date May 14th, 1915, and which deed was recorded May 17th, 1915, in deed record 13 page 154 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, by which deed their undivided one-third interest in said property was conveyed to me.
