State of Iowa, Madison County, ss. We, Ephraim Moore and W.T. Moore, both of Madison County, Iowa, on oath say that we are the sons of Thomas L. Moore, who died intestate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about the 25th day of July, 1902; that said Thomas L. Moore was the same and identical person as T.L. Moore, to whom John A. Macumber and wife on or about February 24, 1866, conveyed the North east Quarter (1/4) of the South east Quarter (1/4) of Section twenty (20), in Township seventy-five (75) North, of Range twenty-eight (28), west of the 5th P.M. Iowa, the deed appearing of record in Deed Record Q of Madison County, Iowa, at page 474 thereof, and that said John A. Macumber was the same and identical person as John McCumber to whom Jacob Casteel and wife on or about October 13th, 1858, conveyed the same real estate, the deed appearing of record in Deed Record S of Madison County, Iowa, at page 536 thereof, and that said Jacob Casteel is the same and identical person as Jacob Castel, who entered said forty acre tract of real estate. That the said Thomas L. Moore left no widow surviving him; that his estate was long since settled, and his indebtedness paid; that said Thomas L. Moore left surviving as his only children the following named persons and no others, to-wit: Ephraim Moore, W.T. Moore, T.E. Pace, S.E. Bertholf, who are still living, and Anderson Moore and Silvanus Moore, who have died since the death of said Thomas L. Moore; that he had no adopted children, and no child or children of any deceased child surviving him, the six children herein before named being his sole and only heirs at law. That neither said W.T. Moore nor William M. Moore, a son of Anderson Moore is the same person as Will Moore against whom unpaid taxes appear in Jackson Township, in Madison County, Iowa.
