State of Iowa, Warren County. ss: I, J. H. Henderson, on oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Warren County, Iowa, all of my lifetime, sixty-seven years; that I was personally acquainted with M. C. Randleman, who formerly owned the following described land to-wit: The West Half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-four (24), in township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-nine (29) West of the 5th Principal Meridian.

That he lived near Carlisle, Warren County, Iowa, and was captain of the Company of the 10th Iowa Infantry of the Civil War, of which regiment my father was the colonel.

That I knew him for many years after the Civil War until about the time of his death and that wherever in the chain of title his name is given as Martin C. Randleman, or M. C. Randleman it is one and the same person.

These facts I state from personal knowledge.
