State of Iowa, Madison County. ss. I, Mary A. Reed, of said County and State, on oath say that I am a daughter of David Bradshaw of Madison County, Iowa; that David Bradshaw died testate in said county on or about March 19th 1893; that he left surviving him his widow, Mary Bradshaw, and his only heirs his son J.W. Bradshaw, his grand daughter Nellie Bradshaw, now Nellie McKee, and myself; that said J.W. Bradshaw died intestate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about February 15, 1895, leaving surviving him his widow Lorinda Bradshaw, and as his only heirs at law his children L.B. Bradshaw, Valter Bradshaw, and Grace M. Bradshaw, now Grace M. Jones. That the estate of said J.W. Bradshaw was long since settled; that Lorinda Bradshaw, widow of J.W. Bradshaw died intestate on or about Oct. 26-12 leaving no husband surviving, and as her only heirs at law the above named children of J.W. Bradshaw; they being also her only children, and that her estate has been fully settled. That Mary Bradshaw, my mother, the widow of David Bradshaw afterwards married William Bradshaw; that his death preceded her death, and that Mary Bradshaw died intestate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about April 9-12 leaving surviving as her only heirs at law my self, Nellie McKee, L.B. Bradshaw, and Grace M. Jones. That the grantors in a conveyance to Jane Rollins, (her name appearing therein as Jane Rollings) now appearing of record in Deed Record 33 of Madison County, Iowa, at page 631, were my mother, my brother, said J.W. Bradshaw, and myself.
