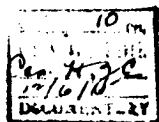
That I was acquainted with the heirs of John Howe, deceased, as filed and named in the registry of heirs filed in said estate on April 9th, 1897, in case No 1296 in probate, of the District Court of Madison county, Iowa, and knew of my own personal knowledge that the J.E.Howe, S.C.Howe, J.H.Howe, A.J.Howe, J.W.Howe, E.E.Howe and L.A. Mease named in said registry of heirs are one and the same identical persons, respectively, as the J.E.Howe, Samuel C.Howe, Jacob H.Howe, A.J.Howe, James W.Howe, Erastus Howe and Laura A.Mease who executed a certain deed to said premises to Wm.Painter, which deed was filed for record April 1st, 1899 and recorded in deed record 31, page 389 thereof, of the official records of Madison county, Iowa, and together with the S.C.Howe who executed the quit claim deed dated April 13th, 1897, conveying above described land to J.H.Howe, which deed was recorded April 19th, 1897, in deed record 34, page 238 of the records aforesaid, were the only heirs at law of the aforesaid John Howe, deceased.
