Hill, being first duly affirmed, deposes and say that I am personally acquainted with L.W.Bingman, Grantor in a certain Warranty Deed dated March 12, 1906, said deed being recorded in Town lot deed record 15 page 491, and that the said L.W.Bingman mentioned above is one and the same party as Lieuard Bingman Grantee in a certain Warranty Deed dated March 7, 1900, said deed being recorded in Town lot deed record 12, page 37, conveying Lots 1,2,3, Block 1, Academy Addition to the Town of Earlham, Iowa, and that wherever in the chain of title to Lots 1,2,3, Block 1, Lots 5,6, Block 3, Lots 7,8,9 Block 5, all in Academy Addition to the Town of Earlham, Iowa, the name of L.W.Bingman and Lieuard Bingman appears, it refers to one and the same person.

And that in the clause in the first above mentioned deed wherein it refers to a certain mortgage of \$700.00 this refers to a certain mortgage of \$700.00 said mortgage being dated

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Jan. 30, 1906, recorded in Madison County town lot mortgage record 6, page 14, conveying Lots 1, 2, 3, Block 1, Academy Addition to the Town of Earlham, Iowa.

I further state I am personally and well acquainted with W.A.Lippencott Grenter in a certain Quit Claim Deed dated March 5, 1909, recorded in Madison County town lot Deed record 13, page 15, conveying Lots 5 and 6, Block Three and Lots 7,8 and 9, Block 5, all in Academy Addition to the Town Of Earlham, Iowa, and that the above mentioned W.A.Lippencott is one and the same person as W.A.Lippincott, and that wherever in the chain of title to Lots 1,2,3, Bleck 1, and Lots 5,6, Bleek 3, and Lots 7,8,9 Block 5, Academy Addition to the Town of Earlham, Iowa, the name of Lippincott and Lippencott appears, it refers to one and the same party, the proper way of spelling the family name being Lippincott.

I further state at the time the said W.A.Lippincott made and executed the Quit Claim Deed referred to above, dated March 5, 1909, he was a single and unmarried man and that at this present date he is a single and unmarried man, his last wife being Polly A.Lippincott, sometimes mentioned as P.A.Lippincott, she having died prior to the execution of said Quit Claim Deed.
