State of Iowa, Madison County, ss. I, Harriett I Worley, being first duly sworn do upon my oath depose and say that I am the widow of F.W. Worley, deceased, and am also one of the grantors in a certain deed dated March 1st 1915 wherein Myrtle P. Sankey is grantee said deed being recorded in Book 54 page 481 of the Deed Records in the office of the County Recorder of Madison County, Iowa; that on the 2nd day of March 1911 F.W. Worley bought of and from Lester C. Boddy and wife The North West Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nine (9) and also the North Sixty (60) acres of the West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the said Section Nine (9) all in Township Seventy Five (75) North, Range Twenty Eight (28) West of the 5th P.M., deed for the same being recorded in Deed Record 50 on page 113 and the said F.W. Worley by the terms of the said deed agreed and assumed the payment of a Nine Thousand Five Hundred (\$9,500.00) mortgage then on the said land given to W.K. Folsom. That in dividing the said land on March 1st 1915 Myrtle P. Sankey assumed the payment of \$3454.57 of the said mortgage and Nora T. Breeding assumed the payment of \$6045.43 of the said mortgage the deed to Nora T. Breeding being recorded in Deed Record 54 page 478 of the records in the office of the County Recorder of Madison County, Iowa. That I was also one of the grantors in the deed to Nora T. Breeding above referred to and the date of the said deed to Nora T. Breeding was March 1st 1915.
