Know All Men By These Presents: That at a special meeting of the stockholders of Peru Savings Bank a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Iowa; held at the office of the Bank in East Peru, IOwa, on the first day of June A.D. 1915 after due and legal notice had been given to the stockholders thereof in conformity with its articles of incorporation, Sections 1615 and 1856, laws of the state, at which the requisite majority for the stook of said corporation was represented, the following amendment was adopted, by a twothirds vote of the stock interests of said Bank, as shown below:

Amendment:

Resolved, That Articl III of the Articles of Incorporation be amended as follows: By striking out the words and figures Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10000,00) and inserting in lieu thereof the words and figures,

Pifteen Thousand Dollars , (\$15000,00) so that said Sec Three (3) will read as follow "The capital stock of this corporation shall be Fifteen Thousand Dollers (15000,00), and shall be divided into shares of One hundred dollars (\$100) each, and shall be fully paid be fore the corporation begins the transaction of its business."

The additional stock shall be apportioned among the several stock holders as determined at a stockholders meeting held April 29th, 1915, at this meeting, the new stock was subscribed for and pledged to be fully paid immediately after the adoption of this amendment,

The President and Casnier of the Bank were duly authorized and directed to sign, ackhowledge, record, publish and do all things which are by law required, to execute, complete and carry into effect the above amendment to the articles of incorporation of said Bank
