Also that I was acquainted with R.L. Tidrick, mentioned at No.4, and know of my own personal knowledge that he was single at the time of making deed to describe lands, in 1853:

I further state that I am a brother of Moses I. Iiams who was one of the defendants in the proceedings to quiet the title shown at No.10 of the abstract, and that he and Moses I. Iames mentioned in abstract at No.2 were one and the same person, identical;

And I also state that I am a son of Jesse Iiams and Mary Iiams mentioned at No.18 in abstract of title, and that the Mortgage of \$700 given to them at No.15 of abstract was given to secure for them maintenance through life, and that they are both dead, having died several years ago, and that said Mortgage is consequently void.
