APTICLES OF INCORPOPATION

Madison County State Bank of Winterset, Iowa.

The persons whose names are subscribed hereto, and all other persons who shall become stockholders of this corporation, hereby associate themselves together as abody corporate and organize and create a corporation under Chapter 1 of Title LX of the Code of Iowa, and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for the government of such association:

ARTICLE I.

Nume and Place of Business.
The name of the corporation shall be "Madison County State Bank", and its place of business. ness shall be in the city of Winterset; County of Madison and State of Iowa

ARTICLE II.

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation shall be a general banking business, conducted and carried on under the provisions of Chapters 11 and 12 or Title IX of the Code of Iowa and acts of the legislature amendatory thereto; and to that and it shall have power to have perpetual succession; to sue and he sued by its corporate nume; to have a common seal, which it may alter at pleasure; to receive deposits; to discount notes, bills and other securities; to buy and sell exchange, bonds, notes, mortgages gold and silver; to loan money; to exercise all of the powers conferred upon banking corporations organized under the laws of the State of Iowa and conducting business under the provisions of Chapters 11 and 12 of Title IX of the Code; to act as receiver, assignee, guardian, admisistrator, or other trustee, when appointed by will or by any court of record in this state; to act as fiscal or transfer agents, or registrar for estates, municipalities, companies or corporations; to take, accept and execute, any and all such trusts and powers of whatsoever character and description, not in conflict with the laws of the United States or of the State of Iowa, as provided by Chapter 152, laws of the 35th General Assembly.

ARTICLE III.

Capital Stock. The capital stock of this corporation shall be Or.e, Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000,00 and shall be divided into shares of one hundred dollars (\$100) each, and shall be fully paid before the corporation begins the transaction of its business.

Articles IV.

The existance of this corporation shall begin on the date the Secretary of State issues Duration. his certificate of incorporation and shall continue Twenty years thereafter; and the corporation may commence, the transaction of business when a certificate of the Auditor of State shall have been issued authorizing it to do so,

Article V. Board of Directors and Officers.

section I. The affairs of this corporation shall be conducted and managed by a board of five directors, who shall be elected from the stockholders at the annual meeting of the corporation, and shall hold office for the term of eneyear, and until their successors are elected and qualified and have accepted effice.

Sec. 2. Any vacancy in the heard of directors shall be filled by the remaining members of the board, and the persons so appointed shall held effice until the next annual meeting

Seq. 3. The board of directors shall sleet a president and vice-president from its members. Who had shall also elect a cashier from the atockholders, who may or may not be a member of the board of directors, and who shall also act as secretary of the corporation. It may also elect and employ such other efficers and clerks as may be necessary in the transaction of its business, and shall fix the compensation of all efficers and employ-

ARTICLE VI.
Amual and Special Meetings of Steckholders,

Section 1. The annual meeting of the stockholders shall be held at the effice of the corporation on the 1st day of January of each year, beginning with the year 1916, at which time, the stockholders shall elect a board of directors and transact such other business as may lawfully come, before them.

dent, or by a majority of the stockholders may be called by the president, vice-president, or by a majority of the members of the board of directors, or by the helder or includers of a majority of the stock of the corporation. Ten (10) days notice of the time and place of such meeting shall be given by the cashier, or the person or persons calling such special meeting, by mailing a notice in writing to each steckholder, direct of the address as shown upon the books of the corporation, which notice shall state the object of the meeting, and no business other than that named in the notice shall be transacted at such special meeting, unless all of the stock of the corporation shall be represented, and no objection shall be made by any stockholder to the transaction of business other than that named in the notice.

Sec 3, The voting at all stockholders' meetings shall be by ballet, and each share of steak represented by the holder thereof, or by his proxy duly authorized in writing, shall be entitled to one vete.

ARTICLE VIII.

Annual Meeting of Board of Directors.
The warnual meeting of the board of directors shall be held on the First day of January, 1916, and immediately following the adjournment of the annual meeting of the stockholders, at which time it shall exect a president, vice-president and cashier, and may elect or employ such other efficers, clocks or employed as shall be deemed necessary for the transaction of the business of the corporation. ARTICLE IX.
Execution and acknowledgment of written instruments

Bection 1. All deeds, mortgages and instruments in writing arrecting real estate which shall be made by the corporation, shall be executed and acknowledged in the name of the

Sec 2. Releases of mortgages and other liens held by the corporation, and satisfaction ther may be made, executed and acknowledged by the president, vice-president on cashier of the he nk.

Sec 3. All other written instruments which may be made by the corporation shall be executed by such efficers or agents as the by-laws may designate.

> ARTICLE X Certificates of Stock.

Section 1. The shares of stock of the corporation shall be issued only upon full payment of the sums represented by them, and shall be transferable only by assignment upon the books of the corporation.

Sec 2. The certificate of stock issued to the shareholders shall be signed by the president er vice-president, and attested by the cashier, and have the corporate seal affixed therete

> ARTICLE XI. Indebtedness.

The highest amount of indebtedness to which this corporation may at any time subject itself except for deposits, shall not exceed its capital stock.

> APTICLE, XII. Exemption of Private Property.

The private property of the stockholders shall be exempt from corporate liability, except to the extent and in the manner provided by the constitution and laws of the State.

> APTICLE XUIT. By-Laws.

The board of directors may, by a two-thirds vote, make and adopt by-laws which are not in conflict with the laws of the State or these articles of incorporation, for the management of the property of the corporation, the transaction of its business, and the regulation of its affairs; and may by a like vote alter or change such by-laws.

APTICLE XIV Amendment of articles of Incorporation. The e articles of incorporation may be amended at any regular meeting of the stockholders or at a special meeting called for that purpose, by a two-thirds vote of the capital steck of the corporation.

ARTICLE XV Dissolution.

This corporation may be dissolved prior to the time fixed in its articles of incorporation by an affirmative vote of its stockholders holding three-feurths of its capital stock, at a meeting of the stockholders called for that purpose in the manner required by law and these articles of incorporation; and in case of such dissolution its affairs shall be wound up

in the manner provided by statute.
