Steele, of said County and State, being sworn depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than 35 years and I am well acquainted with Henry L. Smith who is named as grantee in the deed recorded in Book 11 of Town Lot Deed Record, page 436 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa, And the Henry L. Smith who is named as grantee in the deed recorded in Book Number 16 on page 593 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa, I am also well acquainted with Henry Smith who is named as one of the defendants in the suit of C. E. Woods, plaintiff, vs. J. P. Breeding, Sheriff of Madison County, Iowa, and Henry Smith. That the said Henry L. Smith who is named as grantee in the deeds aforesaid is a different person from the said Henry Smith named as one of the defendant in the cause aforesaid, and the judgment shown on Judgment Docket W at page 53 against Henry Smith is not a judgment against the said Henry L. Smith. And the said Henry L. Smith was not a party to said action and had no connection therewith whatever. And he never resided in Walnut Township or in Peru, Madison County, Iowa, but the said Henry Smith did reside at one time in Peru, Madison County, Iowa, and was in the employ of the Chicago, Great Western Railway Company.

And the delinquent taxes of \$9.01 assessed against Henry Smith in East Peru, Madison County, Iowa, for the year 1903 is the personal tax against the said Henry Smith who formerly lived in East Peru, Madison County, Iowa, and who was formerly in the employ of said rail road company.
