State of Iowa, Madison County, ss I, Kittie M. Shannon of said County and State on oath say that I am a grand daughter of Edwin R. Guiberson who entered from the United States Government a large amount of land in Madison County, Iowa, and who with his wife Catherine Guiberson on or about November 22nd, 1850 conveyed to Jacob Fry the north west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the south west Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section twenty two (22) in township seventy six (76) north, of range twenty eight (28) west of the 5th P.M., Iowa; that if the name of Edwin R. Guiberson appears in said deed as Edwin R. Gueiberson in the deed of conveyance it so appears only by reason of mistake or carelessness in writing, as the true and correct name of the grantor was Edwin R. Guiberson, and his wife, my grand mother was Catherine Guiberson. In other words Edwin R. Guiberson and Edwin R. Gueiberson was one and the same man.
