Wilkinson, being first duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I am well and personally acquainted with Hugh McDonald, named as one of the heirs at law of Francis McDonald, deceased, in the registry of heirs filed in said estate, during his lifetime, and well and personally know that he is the same person as Hugh D. McDonald, minor, who was one of the wards of Luther McDonald, guardian which said guardian brought an action in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, on February 8th, 1904, to mortgage the interest of said minor in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (except one acre off the North side) Section 6 and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, Township 76, North, of Range 28, West 5th P.M.; and I further state that the said Hugh McDonald, heir at law of Francis McDonald, deceased, as above mentioned, and Hugh D. McDonald, minor as above mentioned, are one and the same person as Hugh D. McDonald, one of the defendants in an action of partition in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, in which May Francis Rife was plaintiff and Hugh D. McDonald and W.M. Rife were defendants, in the September Term, A.D. 1903, of said Court, for the partition of the real estate above described, and the same and identical person as Hugh D. McDonald, grantee in a deed from F. D. Campbell, sole referee, dated February 25th, 1904, recorded in Madison County, Iowa in Deed Record 44, Pg. 144.

I further state that I am well and personally acquainted with the said May Francis Rife, Plaintiff in aforesaid action of partition, and well and personally know that she is the same and identical person as May F. McDonald, named as one of the heirs at law in the estate of the said Francis McDonald, deceased, above mentioned.
