State of Iowa, Madison County, ss. I, Lee B. Tidrick of said County and State, on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than fifty years last past, residing during practically all of that time in Winterset, Iowa; that I was well and personally acquainted with Timothy Killam who on or about March 30th, 1872, conveyed to James Harris lot two(2) in Block fourteen (14) in the original town of Winterset, Iowa, and that he was the same and identical person as Timothy Killim, as his name appears of record, to whom H.B. Wells and wife, on or about April 10th, 1868, conveyed said property; that is Timothy Killam and Timothy Killim is one and the same person; that I was well and personally acquainted with Alfred Hood, to whom Mary A. Harris, the surviving widow of James Harris on or about January 5th, 1876, conveyed said property, who on or about March 7th, 1877, conveyed the same to Nellie Stone, and that said Alfred Hood was the same and identical person as the A. Hood to whom O.A. Moser, as administrator of the estate of James Harris, deceased, on or about January 5th, 1876, conveyed the same property.

I personally knew all of the above named persons, and am in no way interested in these matters except to establish the facts stated of record.
