Utter, Martha E. Shutt and husband Micajah Shutt, Frances A. Parker and husband, William Parker, Harriett J. Reed and husband Charles H. Reed, Sarah Ann Reed and husband John Reed, Rosa Johnson and husband, Henry Johnson, Merritt Ogburn and wife Mary Ogburn, Harlan Ogburn and wife, Lizzie Ogburn and William Ogburn and wife, Lena Ogburn, who executed a warranty deed to Rufus Walker dated November 27th, A.D. 1900, and filed for record March 7th, A.D. 1901, conveying the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29, Twp. 74, R. 26, west of the 5th P.M.
